


Don't Get "Writer's Cramp"!



"She tells me all she's getting in her 'love chest, as she calls it, and there's every scrap of my pay that can be spared going towards the same ambition.


"There's my own folks in the little house on Toronto Street, Winnipeg. Mary spends a lot of time with mother.
