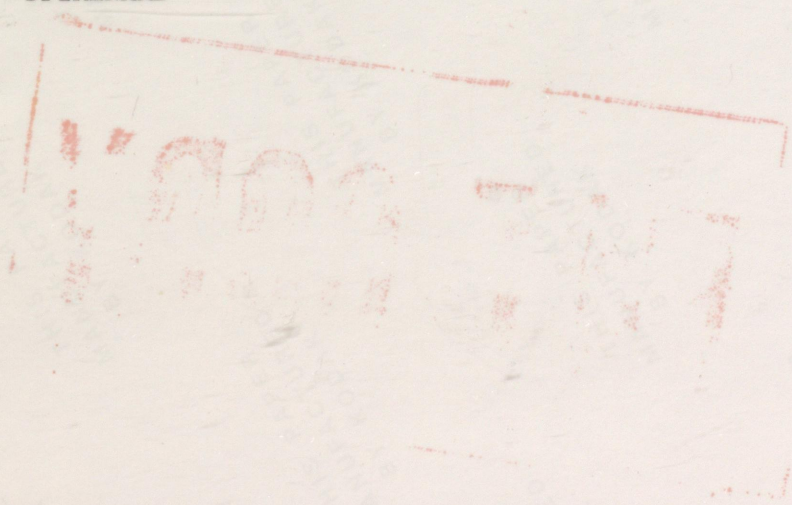

The "Crow's Nest" (officially named the Seagoing Officers' Club) became internationally known among officers of warships and merchant vessels of the United Nations during the war as a haven of rest and relaxation after North Atlantic voyages. Overlooking the harbor of St. John's, Newfoundland, the "Crow's Nest" is being continued by active and retired naval, army and air force officers.

Of all the plaques, which covered the walls of the "Crow's Nest", and brought to mind warships serving on the North Atlantic convoy lanes, none was more famous than that bearing the name of the corvette, H.M.C.S. "Spikenard" which was lost at sea. Here, guarded by the club's wartime mascot, "Sailor", is the Spikenard plaque, which is made from a plank from the clubroom's floor in which the captain of the corvette had driven a spike during an impromptu spike-driving contest.

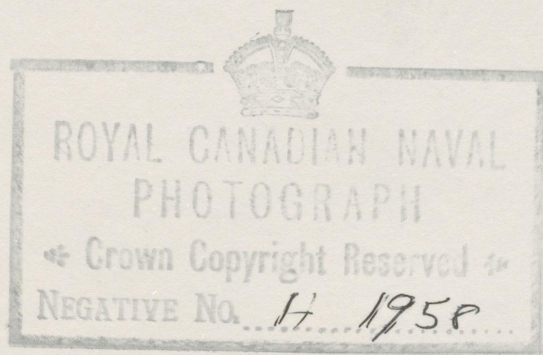


