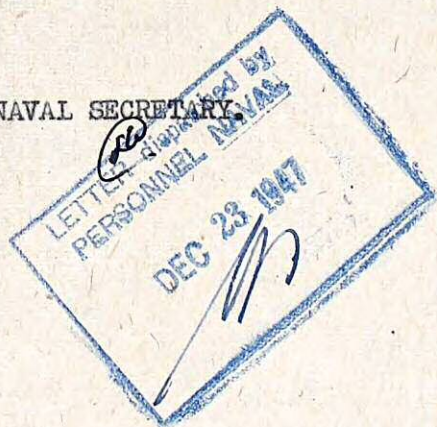

Algiers dated the 13th of April, 1943, he was buried on the 9th of February, 1943, in grave number 144 in the Elalia Cemetery, Algiers.

2. If the late Leading Seaman MacDonald was exhumed from the Elalia Cemetery and buried in the Dely Ibrahim Br. Cemetery, Plot 3, Row C, Grave No. 4, an effort is to be made to secure further details of this reburial, i.e. the date and reason for transfer and other pertinent details which might be of interest to the next-of-kin, also a snapshot of this grave if such can be procured.
