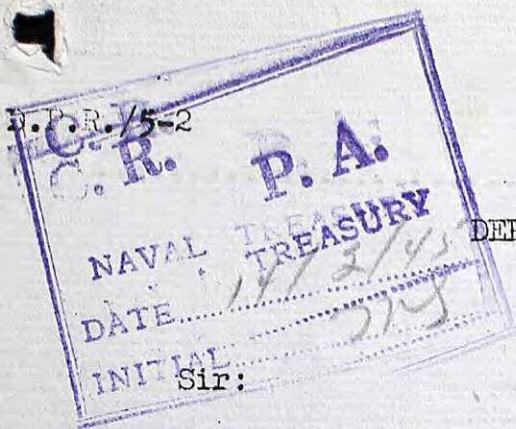



Further to my letter of the 7th of December, 1944, I regret to inform you that in view of the length of time which has elapsed since your husband Walter Bertie Sealey, Able Seaman, Official Number V-11500, Royal Canadian Naval Volunteer Reserve, was reported missing from H.M.C.S. "SHAWINIGAN", and as no news has since been received to the contrary, the Canadian Naval Authorities have now presumed his death to have occurred on the 24th of November, 1944.


