# PLEASE REPLACE DIVOTS.

## LOCAL RULES.

1—Out of bounds :—

[Penalty—Distance only.]

- (a) Ball in plantations to right of No. 6, 7, and 17 Fairways.
- (b) Ball over Fence at 16th.
- (c) Ball outside the boundary of the Course.

2—Ball lying in any of the drains may be lifted and dropped behind under penalty of one stroke.

2a—Ball in any of the following drains may be lifted and dropped behind without penalty :—In front of 8th tee ; to left of 8th Green ; at "quarry" at 18th.

3—Ball lost in play on Putting Greens may be lifted in the presence of an opponent and replaced without penalty.

4—A ball buried in its own impression on the fairway, or lying in a rabbit scrape, may be lifted and dropped without penalty ; if buried on the Green it may be lifted and placed.

5—A ball played on to a Green in error must be lifted and dropped off the Green and not nearer the hole. (No penalty).

6—If a Player's stroke be interfered with by the fence along 16th Fairway, the ball may be lifted and dropped not more than two club-lengths from the fence, but not nearer the hole. (No penalty).

7—In the event of a tie in a Match-play Competition, play must be continued until one of the players has holed out. (Strokes to be counted before.)
