With reference to your letter of November 13th, the Casualty Report listed next of kin as wife, "Lillian May Barrow of Sault Ste Marie". There was produced a marriage certificate indicating that Israel Barrow, widower, married Lillian Mae Barber, widow, at Sault Ste Marie on the 23rd July, 1940. According to the report the alleged widow married Gordon Howard Barber on the 1st May, 1919; that in 1924 she left him and commenced to live with Israel Barrow and was known as the latter's wife at various places in Ontario and Saskatchewan. It was alleged that Mr. Barrow was previously married at Bury, Lancs., England, and that he left his wife at Consort, Alberta, in 1920 or 1921.

Mr. P.T. Rowland, K.C., of Sault Ste Marie, stated that after Mr. Barrow enlisted the alleged wife confessed that they were not married and at Mr. Rowland's suggestion a marriage ceremony was performed on the 23rd July, 1940. It is quite evident that both parties entered into this ceremony on the presumption that their former spouses were dead.

It is interesting to note that about a year after the woman commenced living with Barrow her husband, Barber, returned and both men lived in the same house with her on two occasions.

The Commission awarded pension to the woman observing that irrespective of the validity of the marriage she would still be entitled under Section 32-3. Pension was also awarded for six children, one born of the woman's first marriage and the following born of her union with Barrow -

Jack G. born 29.5.26, Robert I. 10.1.30, Ronald N. 16.7.31, Kenneth S. 1.7.35, and William H. 22.8.37.

With regard to the children the Commission observed that marriage, if legal, would legitimate them, but that if the marriage was illegal they would still be eligible under Section 22-3.


I might also state that Mrs. Barrow was remarried to Roland Favian Caron on the 27th March, 1941, and her pension was discontinued with the usual remarriage gratuity. She is still receiving pension on behalf of five children, the child of her first marriage having attained the age limit on the 20th instant. Her address is recorded as —

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

A total of 143 Officers and men were lost in this unfortunate incident.

Petty Officer Barrow's official next-of-kin was his wife, Mrs. Lillian May Barrow, living at 93 Summit Avenue, Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario. Mrs. Barrow has since re-married and is now Mrs. Lillian M. Caron.

Dear Madam:

It is with deep regret that I must confirm the telegram sent out by the Minister of National Defence, reporting that your husband, Israel Barrow, Stoker P.O., O.N. X41077, R.C.N., was missing, believed killed.

Few details are available, but it is known that H.M.C.S. "MARGAREE" was sunk in collision in the North Atlantic whilst steaming without lights, on convoy duty, and in the submarine zone. 142 Officers and ratings are missing and must be presumed lost at sea.

I am requested to express to you the sincere sympathy of the Minister of National Defence for Naval Services and the Chief of the Naval Staff in your bereavement.

Any further information, which is received, will be at once communicated to you.
