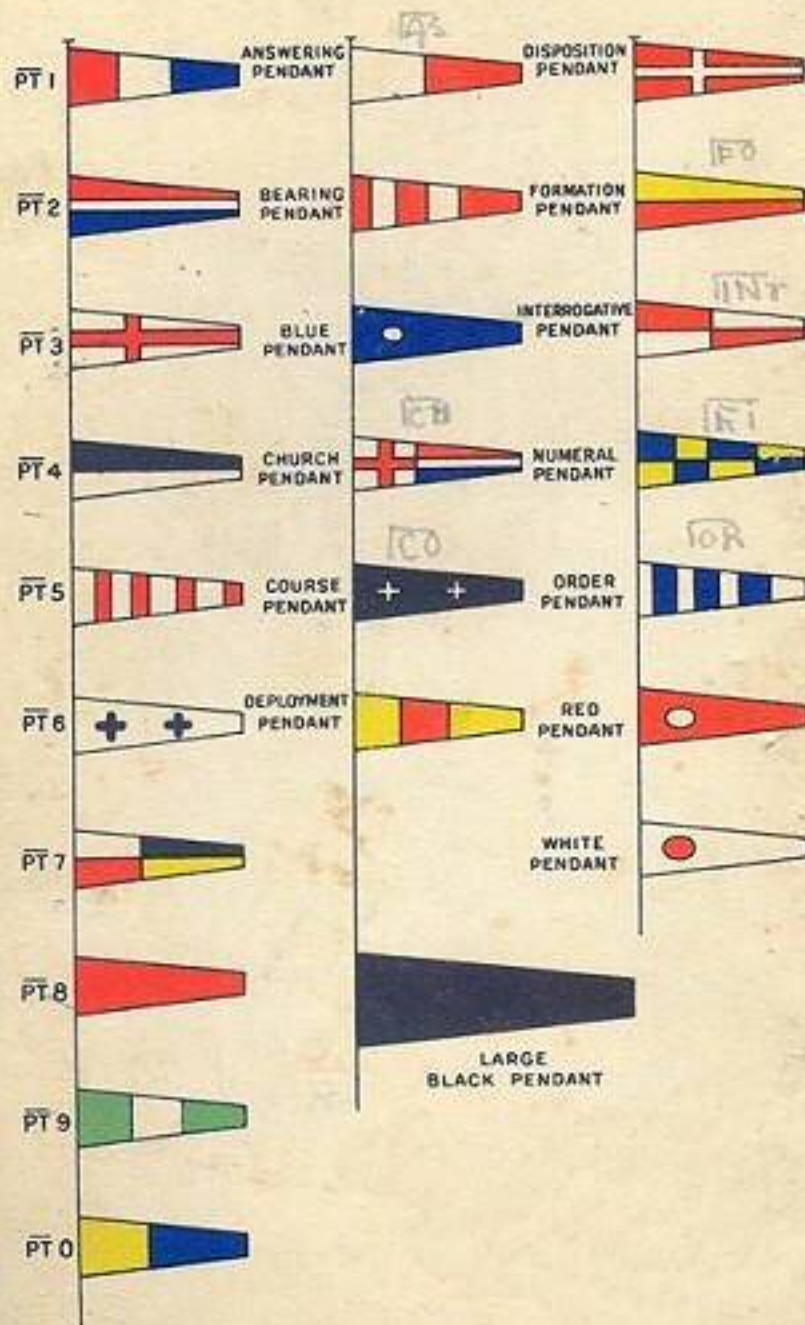


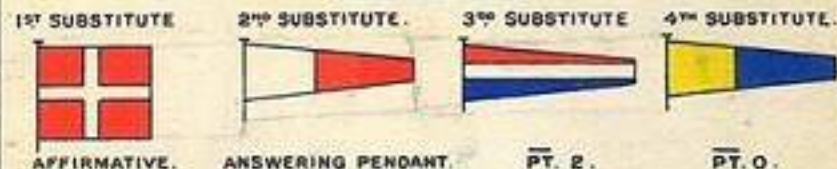
PLATE IV.

SUBSTITUTES.

THE 1ST SUBSTITUTE ALWAYS REPEATS THE UPPER FLAG OR PENDANT OF A SERIES. THE 2ND SUBSTITUTE REPEATS THE SECOND FLAG OR PENDANT, THE 3RD SUBSTITUTE REPEATS THE THIRD FLAG, AND THE 4TH SUBSTITUTE REPEATS THE FOURTH FLAG.

Note:-The Numeral Pendant when hoisted between Numeral flags is not to be considered as breaking the series.

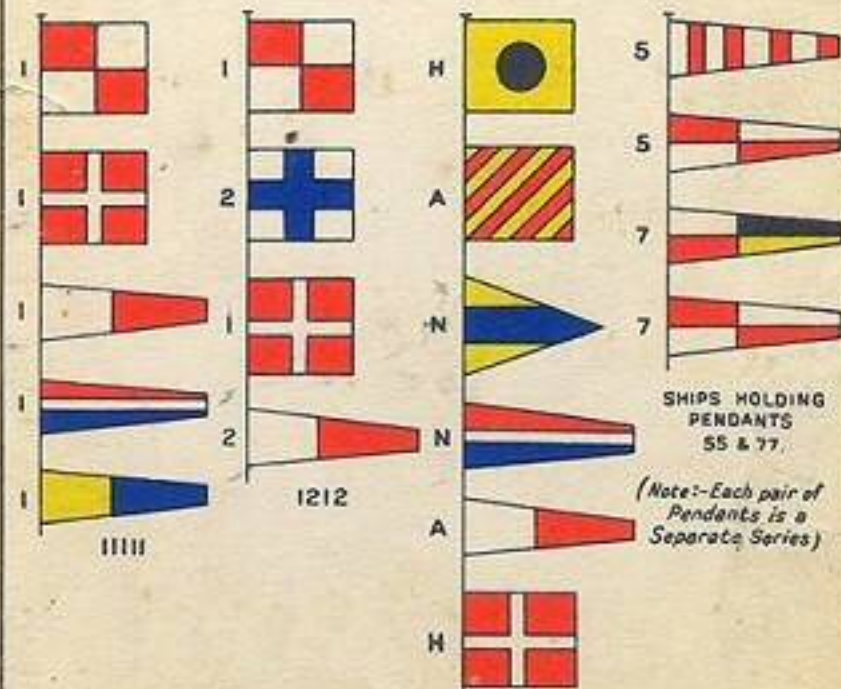

2. THE SPACE BETWEEN ELEMENTS WHICH FORM THE SAME LETTER, FIGURE, OR SYMBOL IS EQUAL TO ONE SHORT.
3. THE SPACE BETWEEN TWO LETTERS, FIGURES, OR SYMBOLS IS EQUAL TO THREE SHORTS (I.E., ONE LONG).
4. THE SPACE BETWEEN TWO WORDS IS EQUAL TO FIVE SHORTS.
