

Mrs. Mary Webb, the wife of the above party, has consulted me regarding the stoppage by her husband through your Department of the \$55. a month which she receives for the support of herself and her three-year old child.

She advises me that she has not received her December cheque which should have arrived about December 28th last. She phoned up the Commander in Victoria, B.C., and he advised her that her husband had stopped payment of her cheque alleging that she refused to live with her husband.

Mrs. Webb states that this statement is incorrect as it is her husband who refuses to live with her. In support of this statement she has produced to me a letter from her husband dated May 20th, 1935^{and}, for your information I enclose herewith a notarial certified copy of the same, and if you wish the original letter it can be sent to you.

Mrs. Webb and her infant child has no other means of support and ever since she has been married, for the last five years, she has always received the Departmental cheques.

Mrs. Webb advises me that she has never refused and does not now refuse to live with her husband.

I shall be much obliged if you will kindly advise me what can be done to have Mrs. Webb's cheques forwarded to her and I shall do anything at this end to assist you in this respect.


CERTIFICATE OF DEATH
