VI OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION: Dark, sharp-featured rating of average build (5'8" 155 lbs) - boyish appearance. Has a slightly pretentious way of talking - speaks in a flat tone of voice. Comes from an affluent family in Kitchener - Father is manager of Dominion Rubber Co. Has one older sister.
States that he is keenly interested in aeronautics, and intends to take aeronautical engineering at university after the war. Has his own motor-launch and automobile. Played on school rugby team and was a member of the gym team for several years. Says he was supervisor of a summer camp for boys near Kitchener in 1940. Likes badminton and skiing.
Learning ability superior (M score 176). Education adequate, but rather weak on the mathematical side. Is still immature and undeveloped in many respects. Thinks along conventional channels, and does not show much capacity for organizing his ideas. On the other hand, his record shows that he has certain potential leadership qualities. During the interview, he seemed to be trying very hard to say just the right thing and to create a favourable impression. It is not felt that he is clearly qualified for a commission at present, but requires a further period of trial.
