PUNISHMENT ROUTINE-SHIPS STANDING ORDERS (SOP'S)

- GENERAL.** An offender who has been sentenced to punishment of confinement to ship, extra work and drill or stoppage of leave, shall not be granted leave of any kind during the term of punishment. The same regulation applies to offenders sentenced to extra work and drill not exceeding two hours, in that no leave will be granted from the first to the last muster.
- DUTY ASHORE.** Offenders sentenced to punishment as noted above may be authorized to carry out duties ashore. Authorization to proceed ashore may be given by the Officer of the Day for duty personnel and Heads of Departments for all others. Men under punishment are to inform the Coxn/Duty Coxn prior to proceeding ashore and upon their return.
